

CHIEF'S MINUTE(S)

June 10, 2020

Incidents – May, 2020 22 total, 11 medical, 3 structure, 2 mva, 3 natural cover, 3 public safety/assist. 2 structure fires were mutual aid to Camas Valley and 1 automatic aid to District 2. 1 mutual aid public assist to TenMile. 1 natural cover response was automatic aid to Dist. 2. Discussion of CV and Lookingglass safety issues.

Training – Most training this month was online due to Covid 19 procedures. We have continued to do equipment and facility maintenance projects, outfitting of units with minimal ffs at the station at one time.. EMS webinars being attended by our medical personnel for CEUs. Had our first regular meeting May 28 with wildland training, and then a Captains meeting and equipment/safety meeting June 2. We are using Phase 2 guidelines for Covid 19.

Firefighters - Map update project finished. Emergency Medical Responder recertification continues. Brush hogged and cleaned up facility again, burned accumulated natural waste.

Explorers - Participated in all ff tasks. Our renewed Workers Comp includes the Cadet Firefighters for \$376/year.

Equipment - 1081 has a carburetor/choke issue. Running now and new carburetor being donated. Mounted tools and ladder on 1080. Fuel order (diesel) received June 1st – 300 gallons. 1 SCBA regulator failed on Camas Valley fire, no injury and repair has been made.

Inventory - Continuing placement of equipment on units and identifying surplus equipment for disposal/donation per Board approval. No purchases or equipment coming in as year ends. Due to Covid19, medical supply spending has increased. Still within budget. All needs are available from our vendors. Will be applying for reimbursement of costs due to Covid19 through FEMA.

Facility Covid 19 Phase 2 directives being met, and basically the same as Phase 1 for our facility. Had one Zoom Board meeting and two budget meetings at the Grange. Emergency generator and transfer switch have been wired and installed, 3 hour shutdown of Station June 3rd. Transferred phone to my cell for 3 hours through DFN. Next will be gas line plumbing and then inspection with meter placement.

Office/Admin – SDAO/SDIS workers comp invoice arrived, due Aug. 1st. About \$200 under budget including coverage for Cadet Firefighters.

FEMA Grant applications undergoing peer review, apparently process is being fast tracked.

VFA Grant deadline was extended, so it is not done yet and usually would be available for this meeting. Budget committee meetings conducted and approved Budget sent to Board for approval. Budget hearing earlier tonight, all notices posted as required. LB1, LB50 completed and Resolution prepared for adoption.

Safety/security grant received from SDAO (\$5000), amount forwarded to Sabin Electric for balance of Emergency Generator project.

Bi annual DPSST certification of LRFD scheduled June 13 at 1 pm. Annual air system maintenance scheduled for June 9 at 1 pm.

Miscellaneous - Budget hearing and Board meeting to be conducted at Grange and online tonight..

Expect Fire season to start either June 10th or shortly after. The recent precipitation is helping delay.
